

## **Concert Attire Announcement**

Beginning this fall, Harmonium is moving towards being more inclusive and financially less burdensome to its members by expanding its concert attire options. Please see below:

**Color:** Concert black (solid)

### **Tops options**

Sleeve length: Cap sleeve (as with “the” dress) or ¾ length or long sleeve.  
**NO sleeveless** or strapless.

Style: Black Shirt or blouse

Jacket (from tux is fine) over black shirt/blouse, (jacket not required)

**NO T-shirts**, polo shirts or crop tops. **NO** sheer tops.

### **Bottoms options**

Length: Full

Style: Skirt - “full” length means to the ankles or floor

Pants/Slacks

**NO jeans** or leggings

### **Other options**

Tux with black shirt

“The” dress

Cardigan sweater for colder concerts

### **Footwear**

Black socks or hose

Black shoes

**Facial masks:** Black only

There is a \$10 discount on black mask(s) at Cousins Concert Attire, using code MAS1800.

In addition, Anne welcomes a splash of Harmonium red (i.e. primary red) with your concert black outfit. Such items as a red tie, handkerchief or scarf; a silk rose, jewelry, hairband or socks could provide that splash. The splash of red should be solid, and not a pattern or print.
