

HARMONIUM TO CELEBRATE THE JOYS OF SINGING

Harmonium Choral Society, known for its ability to communicate the joys of singing to an audience, will conclude its twenty-fifth anniversary season with the program *Cantare del Cantare* - Singing about Singing - presented on both Saturday, June 4th and Sunday, June 5th at 7:30pm. This celebration of singing will feature **two** world premieres: a commission by American composer Edie Hill and the winning composition of the 2005 contest by Chatham High School senior Dale Trumbore. Other works on the program range from sixteenth-century French to twentieth-century Russian, with Bosnian and African folk songs, Shaker tunes and American spirituals.

The concerts will be held at Grace Episcopal Church on Madison Avenue at Kings Road in Madison, New Jersey. Audience members can meet the composers at the reception following each concert. General admission tickets will be available at the door for \$20 and \$15 for students and seniors. Discounts are available for those who purchase at least one week in advance: \$18 for regular tickets and \$13 for students or seniors. Tickets are also \$10 for groups of ten or more who reserve at least one week in advance. The church is wheelchair accessible; and large print and braille programs will be made available if requested ahead of time.
